Cliff Berry II has been with the Board of Directors of Seafarers' House since 1999. He served as Vice President from 2002 to 2005 and again from 2014 until today.

Mr. Berry is President of Cliff Berry Inc., a Fort Lauderdale-based company offering emergency response environmental services with facilities across Florida.
